

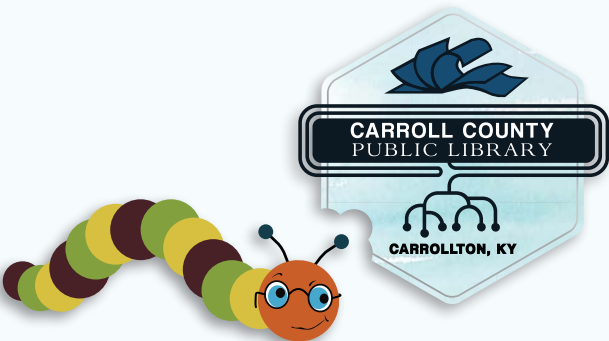

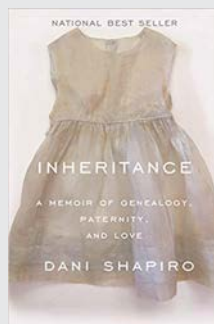


## What's on Display

Your response matters.

Health clinics. Fire departments. Schools. Even roads and highways. The census can shape many different aspects of our community. Census results help determine how billions of dollars in federal funding flow into states and communities each year.

When you respond to the census, your answers are kept anonymous. They are used only to produce statistics. The U.S. Census Bureau is bound by law to protect your answers and keep them strictly confidential.

Invitations to respond to the 2020 Census will be delivered between March 12-20. Once you receive that invitation, you can respond online, by phone, or by mail.
